Since the founding of our nation in 1840 the beaches, foreshore and seabed belonged to the Crown (i.e. the public) – as is the case in all those countries that follow British law. However, in 2011 the National government, for no other reason than to buy the parliamentary votes of the small, race based Maori Party, passed the thieving and racist Marine and Coastal Area Act, which took the priceless resource of the foreshore and seabed out of public ownership so that coastal tribes/tribal groups could claim them for the first time. And this in spite of the fact that there are no longer any full-blooded Maoris and apparently not even any half blood ones. Instead, certain groups of people – part-Maoris with more European blood in them than Maori – are now able to claim race based rights over and above those of other New Zealanders. Shades of apartheid South Africa when people of a certain race were not allowed to step on certain beaches.

The ramifications of the Marine and Coastal Area Act are now being felt on the East Coast with the greedy and opportunistic claim by a part-Maori activist, on behalf of the Rongomaiwahine tribe to customary marine title (effectively full ownership) of ALL the foreshore and seabed of the Mahia Peninsula, from Paritu to the mouth of the Nuhaka River. The great Deception! When asked at a Napier meeting, the tribal representative said that the claim was for the protection of burial grounds. On beaches and under water? Really?!

To qualify for customary marine title the tribe must prove that they have had continuing and exclusive use of the peninsula's foreshore and seabed since 1840. This is absurd as boats, fishermen, surfers and others have been using all parts of the peninsula for decades.

This claim is at present before the High Court and the Council of Outdoor Recreational Associations of New Zealand (CORANZ) is opposing it so as to maintain the rights of the public to continue to fish, surf and sail in the area.

Under the Act any lucky tribe that manages to score customary marine title can exclude others from all or part of its successful claim by declaring wahi tapu (forbidden area) – usually over the best fishing grounds and surf breaks.

This attack on public rights by the Rongomaiwahine tribe must be resisted in the interests of continued public access - AS OF RIGHT - to the beaches of the peninsula.

You can help ensure a democratic and non-racist New Zealand, with equal rights for all, by contributing to CORANZ's legal costs in this vitally important case that will affect your rights and those of generations unborn.

The country has reached a terrible state when a private organisation like CORANZ has to uphold the public interest because the government fails to do so. We all pay the same taxes, we are all liable for service in war time, so why should people with one particular and accidental bloodline to a coastal tribe be given superior rights over other citizens? That is a throwback to the tribalism and feudalism that the chiefs signed the Treaty of Waitangi to get away from.

If we don't stand up for our rights and for a democratic and non-racial New Zealand, then we will soon be second-class citizens in the land built by the sweat and toil of our pioneer forebears.
